



## FEEDING THE WORLD

One million water bottles and napkins, 500,000 pieces of fruit and 80,000 bowls of ice cream were served up to athletes from all over the world, team officials, media representatives and delegates at the Commonwealth Games this year.

The 12-day event kept Delaware North Companies International busy catering 400,000 meals for event participants.

The Athlete's Village dining hall alone seated 1600 people and was open round the clock providing thousands of meals a day.
