## Position: substitute bench

**Name:** Emirates Stadium

**Facilities:** Four large flexible spaces cater for up to 600 delegates with pitch views. Network bar areas and 150 executive boxes will be offered for breakout rooms or more discreet events.

**Additional:** Viewings of Arsenal's new stadium for next year began last month. A media centre with 150 tiered seats and the Director's suite will be available to event planners. Stadium tours will be introduced as part of package deals and outdoor space on the stadium podium is also on offer.

## Position: substitute bench

**Name:** Wembley National Stadium

**Facilities:** Wembley's grandest space will be the Corinthian room, with a banqueting capacity of 1,800 or 3,250 for cocktails. It has an elevated central dining area with a bridge connecting the two side mezzanines. The Pitchview room will be able to host conferences for 50 delegates or a reception for 300. With direct access to dedicated seating outside on the tiers this, one of the smallest rooms, will offer a stadium atmosphere.

**Facilities:** Next year will see 3,700sqm of flexible exhibition and hospitality space open with restaurants and bars on every level. Capacities will range from 1,200 theatre-style for meetings to 2,000 for receptions. A 50-bedroom on-site hotel is planned for 2008.
